Expert Group Meetings for 2025 HLPF Thematic Review

The 2025 High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF) will center on driving inclusive, science-guided, and sustainable approaches to delivering on the 2030 Agenda and SDGs. SDGs on health (goal 3), gender equality (goal 5), economic growth (goal 8), conservation of oceans (goal 14), and partnership for implementation (goal 17), shall have their SDGs reviewed to monitor their implementation and determine actions to drive implementation in the next five years. The forum shall align with other global processes like UN Ocean Conference and FfD4. Expert Group Meetings (EGMs) shall aggregate varied stakeholders to provide insight, identify challenges, and give transformative approaches. Outputs shall inform deliberations through in-depth background papers and brief summaries of their outputs.

Team Up for Climate Challenge 2025 (United States)(New)

The Team Up for Climate Challenge 2025 by the Fondation Egis invites students and recent graduates (18+ years) worldwide to form teams of 2-5 members to develop innovative solutions addressing climate risks. The UNHCR Nansen Refugee Award recognizes individuals, groups, or organizations that have made extraordinary efforts to protect and assist refugees, internally displaced, or stateless people. The global laureate receives US\$100,000, with US\$25,000 for regional winners. Eligible candidates must demonstrate a significant positive impact on displaced populations, often exceeding their expected roles. Nominations are encouraged for work related to statelessness but are not limited to it. Applications must include three references and be submitted in English, French, Spanish, or Arabic by April 7, 2025.

Call for Applications: Zayed Sustainability Prize

Applications are now open for the Zayed Sustainability Prize, which rewards small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs), nonprofit organizations (NPOs), and global high schools for their innovative and impactful sustainable solutions. Established by the UAE in 2008, the prize honors the humanitarian legacy of the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan. The prize is awarded in five categories: Health, Food, Energy, Water, and Climate Action, as well as a Global High Schools category for student-led sustainability projects. The total prize fund of US \$5.9 million is distributed across these categories, with US \$1 million allocated to each of the first five and US \$900,000 for high schools. Eligible organizations must demonstrate long-term plans for scaling their solutions, while high school projects must be innovative, feasible, and beneficial to their communities.
