Expert Group Meetings for 2025 HLPF Thematic Review

The 2025 High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF) will center on driving inclusive, science-guided, and sustainable approaches to delivering on the 2030 Agenda and SDGs. SDGs on health (goal 3), gender equality (goal 5), economic growth (goal 8), conservation of oceans (goal 14), and partnership for implementation (goal 17), shall have their SDGs reviewed to monitor their implementation and determine actions to drive implementation in the next five years. The forum shall align with other global processes like UN Ocean Conference and FfD4. Expert Group Meetings (EGMs) shall aggregate varied stakeholders to provide insight, identify challenges, and give transformative approaches. Outputs shall inform deliberations through in-depth background papers and brief summaries of their outputs.

NPDRR Stakeholders Meeting Held

The National Platform for Disaster Risk Reduction (NPDRR) held a stakeholders' meeting at NDRRMA on February 25, 2025, chaired by Dr. Bhisma Kumar Bhusal, focusing on strengthening thematic groups for enhanced disaster resilience.
