The United Nations–Nippon Foundation Fellowship (New)

The United Nations–Nippon Foundation Fellowship (UNNF) offers a 9-month advanced training program for mid-level government officials and professionals from developing countries working in ocean affairs and the law of the sea. The Emerging Climate Champions Award is a \$25 million global initiative launched by Enlight Foundation, The Patchwork Collective, and Lever for Change to support youth-led organizations (ages 15–35) advancing climate solutions worldwide. Planet2050 has launched a Request for Proposals (RFP) to fund projects focused on permanent carbon removals as part of a broader goal to achieve net-zero emissions. The initiative supports early-stage and scalable projects using technology-based or hybrid carbon dioxide removal (CDR) methods like biochar, BECCS, and enhanced weathering, with investments up to €2 million per project. Selected projects must demonstrate carbon storage permanence of at least 100 years and use ICROA-accredited standards such as Verra or Gold Standard. Projects must be at least at Technology Readiness Level 7 and able to issue credits within 6 to 24 months. Transparency, environmental safety, legal compliance, and community engagement are emphasized, and short-listed applicants will need to submit full documentation for final evaluation.

John and Maria Laffin Trust Grant Program in the US

The John and Maria Laffin Trust provides grants to qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations supporting education, animal welfare, medical research, and human services. Educational and animal welfare grants (20% and 30% of funds, respectively) are limited to institutions and organizations in Los Angeles City and County, California. Medical research and human services grants (25% each) have no geographic restrictions, allowing U.S.-based nonprofits to support global causes, including efforts to alleviate human suffering and starvation worldwide. Grants typically range from \$5,000 to \$10,000, with around 25 awarded annually. Only U.S.-based 501(c)(3) organizations are eligible to apply.
